PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 3) Act, 2023.

Amendments of certain written laws

2. The written laws specified in various Parts of this Act are amended in the manner specified in their respective Parts.

PART II  
AMENDMENT OF THE EXPORT PROCESSING ZONES ACT,  
(CAP. 373)

Construction Cap. 373

3. This Part shall be read as one with the Export Processing Zones Act, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”.

Amendment of section 2

4. The principal Act is amended in section 2 by deleting the definition of the term “Minister” and

substituting for it the following:

““Minister” means the Minister responsible for export processing zones;”.

Amendment  
of section 14

5. The principal Act is amended in section 14(2) by deleting the words “responsible for industries” appearing in paragraph (a).

**AMENDMENT OF THE SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONES ACT,**  
**(CAP. 420)**

Construction  
Cap. 420

6. This Part shall be read as one with the Special Economic Zones Act, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Act”.

Amendment  
of section 3

7. The principal Act is amended in section 3 by deleting the definition of the term “Minister” and substituting for it the following:

““Minister” means the Minister responsible for special economic zones;”.
