1. These Rules may be cited as the Petroleum (Wholesale, Storage, Retail and Consumer Installation Operations) (Amendment) Rules, 2023 and shall be read as one with the Petroleum (Wholesale, Storage, Retail and Consumer Installation Operations) Rules, 2023 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Rules”.

Deletion and
substitution of
rule 8

2. The principal Rules are amended by deleting rule 8 and substituting for it the following;

“Duration of
construction
approval

8 -(1) The construction approval issued by the Authority shall cease to have effect in the event the holder thereof fails to commence construction within twenty four months from the date of issue.

(2) The Authority may, on its own motion or upon receipt of an application by a holder of a construction approval, extend the validity of the construction approval for such period as it may think fit.

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(3) The Authority shall, while making a decision under sub rule 2, consider all the following factors:

- (a) the economic viability of the project;
- (b) the applicant's commitment towards commencing the construction;
- (c) change of the Government policy and law that affects the project;
- (d) any other factor that may have an impact on the implementation of the project; or
- (e) any other factor which is relevant in the implementation of the project.”
