Citation and

1. This Order may be cited as the Value Added Tax (Exemption)(President's Office Regional Administration and Local Government) (Provision of Consultancy Services for Customisation and Implementation of Asset Management Module in EPICOR IFMIS) (M/s Soft Tech Consultants Limited) Order, 2020 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2019.

Exemption

2. Subject to the conditions specified in paragraph 3 of this Order, and any other conditions as may be specified by the Commissioner, the whole of the Value Added Tax payable on the provision of services imported or locally purchased by or on behalf of M/s Soft Tech Consultants Limited to be used solely in the project of Provision of Consultancy Services for Customisation and Implementation of Asset Management Module in EPICOR IFMIS is hereby exempted.

Conditions

3. The exemption granted under this Order shall cease to have effect and the Value Added Tax shall be due and payable as if this exemption had not been granted where the said services are used for other purpose or provided in any way to another
