THE VALUE ADDED TAX (EXEMPTION) (CONSTRUCTION OF GOVERNMENT CITY ROADS TO BITUMEN STANDARD (40KM)) (TANZANIA RURAL AND URBAN ROADS AGENCY (TARURA)) (M/S CHINA HENAN INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION GROUP CO. LTD) ORDER, 2020

Citation and
Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Value Added Tax (Exemption) (Construction of Government City Roads to Bitumen Standard (40km)) (Tanzania Rural and Urban Roads Agency (TARURA)) (M/S China Henan International Cooperation Group Co. Ltd) Order, 2020 and shall be deemed to have come in to operation on the 15th day of October, 2019.

Exemption

2.-(1) Subject to the conditions specified in paragraph 3 of this Order, and any other conditions as may be specified by the Commissioner, the whole of the Value Added Tax payable on the goods specified in the Schedule to this Order imported or purchased prior to clearance through customs or locally purchased by or on behalf of M/S China Henan International Cooperation Group Co. Ltd to be used solely in the Construction of Government City Roads to Bitumen Standard (40km) is hereby exempt:

Provided that, the quality and value of goods specified in the Schedule shall be as verified and approved by TARURA.

(2) For avoidance of doubt, the goods

imported or locally purchased in terms of subparagraph (1), shall remain the property of the Government of Tanzania.

Conditions

3. The exemption granted under this Order shall cease to have effect and the Value Added Tax shall become due and be payable as if this exemption had not been made if the said goods are used for other purposes or sold or disposed of in any way to another person not entitled to enjoy similar privileges as are conferred under this Order.

Expiry

4. This Order shall expire on 15th day of April, 2021.
