THE VALUE ADDED TAX (EXEMPTION) (RESILIENT AND SUSTAINABLE SYSTEMS FOR HEALTH PROGRAM) (INSURANCE SERVICE FOR OFFICE MOTOR VEHICLE WITH REGISTRATION NUMBER DFPA 2886) (MINISTRY OF HEALTH, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, GENDER, ELDERLY AND CHILDREN) ORDER, 2020

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Value Added Tax (Exemption) (Resilient and Sustainable Systems for Health Program) (Insurance Service for Office Motor Vehicle with Registration Number DFPA 2886) (Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children) Order, 2020 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 20th day of May, 2020.

Exemption

2. Subject to the conditions specified in paragraph 3 of this Order, and any other conditions as may be specified by the Commissioner General of Tanzania Revenue Authority, the whole of the Value Added Tax payable on insurance service to be provided by National Insurance Corporation on behalf of Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children to be used solely in the project for insurance of Office Motor Vehicle with Registration Number DFPA 2886 is hereby exempted.

Conditions

3. The exemption granted under this Order shall cease to have effect and the Value Added Tax shall become due and be payable as if this exemption had not been made if the said services is used for other purposes or sold or disposed of in

any way to another person not entitled to enjoy similar privileges as are conferred under this Order.
