THE GAMING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023

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| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming (Amendment) Regulations, 2023, and shall be read as one with the Gaming Regulations, 2003, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”. |

| Commencement | 2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 st July, 2023. |
| Amendment of
regulations 67B | 3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 67B by deleting sub regulation (3) and substituting for it the following:

“ (3) The holder of forty machine site licence shall be authorized to place and operate slot machines and not more than two table games in the approved premises.” |
| Amendment of
First Schedule | 4. The principal Regulations are amended in the First Schedule-
(a) by deleting item 32;
(b) in item 4, by deleting the figures “10,000” appearing in the fifth column and substituting for them the figures “30,000”;
(c) by renumbering item 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 42 as item 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40 and 41 respectively;
and
(d) adding immediately after item 41 as amended the following new items: |
