THE VALUE ADDED TAX (EXEMPTION) (NATIONAL TUBERCULOSIS AND LEPROSY PROGRAMME (NTLP)) (PROVISION OF 100 BROADCASTING RADIO SPOTS ON TUBERCULOSIS) (M/S TANZANIA BROADCASTING CORPORATION) (MINISTRY OF HEALTH, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, GENDER, ELDERLY AND CHILDREN) ORDER, 2020

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Value Added Tax (Exemption) (National Tuberculosis and Leprosy Programme (NTLP)) (Provision of 100 Broadcasting Radio Spots on Tuberculosis (M/s Tanzania Broadcasting Corporation) (Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children) Order, 2020 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 19th day of June, 2020.

Exemption

2. Subject to the conditions specified in paragraph 3 of this Order, and any other conditions as may be specified by the Commissioner, the whole of the Value Added Tax payable on the Broadcasting Services of 100 Radio Spots locally purchased by or on behalf of Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children to be used solely in the project of Provision of 100 Broadcasting Radio Spots on Tuberculosis is hereby exempt.

Conditions

3. The exemption granted under this Order shall cease to have effect and the Value Added Tax shall become due and payable as if this exemption had not been granted where the said services are used for other purposes, sold or disposed of in any way to a person who is not entitled to enjoy similar privileges conferred under this Order.

Expiry

4. This Order shall expire on 18th day of September, 2020.
