THE URBAN PLANNING (KALEBEZO PLANNING AREA) ORDER, 2021

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Urban Planning (Kalebezo Planning Area) Order, 2021.

Declaration of

2. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a planning area for the purposes of the Urban Planning Act.

3. General and Detailed Schemes for the scheduled area shall be prepared and deposited with the Director of Urban Planning and Buchosa District Executive Director.

The planning area is contained in the following boundaries

“Commencing at survey mark SV 330 with UTM coordinates 425821.734,9724975.722 the boundary take Southward direction with a distance of 2.9 kilometers at survey mark SV 472 with UTM coordinates 426353.553,9722035.415, thence; continues for a distance of 3,7 kilometers for survey mark SV 437 with UTM coordinates 428369.905,9718930.040 thence; it takes North-east direction for a distance of 1.5 kilometers for survey mark SV 438 with UTM coordinates 429111.474, 9720228.298, thence; it takes North direction with a distance of 0.8 kilometers for survey mark SV 473 with UTM coordinates 429015.116, 9721023.354 thence; it takes North-east direction with a distance of 6.2 kilometers for survey mark SV 648 at UTM coordinates 434393.2531,9724239.4860 thence; it takes North-west direction with a distance of 2.9 kilometers for survey mark SV 443 with UTM coordinates 432146.344,9725199.035, thence; continues for a distance of 2.3 kilometers for survey mark SV 643 with UTM coordinates 429411.7671,9726192.4373,thence; takes North-west direction for a distance of 2.3 kilometers for survey mark SV 645 with UTM coordinates 427546.9636,9727410.6969, thence; it takes South-west direction for a distance of 2.9 kilometers for survey mark SV 330 where it commenced”.
