THE VALUE ADDED TAX (EXEMPTION) (NATIONAL TUBERCULOSIS AND LEPROSY PROGRAMME NTLP)) (PROVISION OF CLEANING SERVICES OF MINISTRY OF HEALTH, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, GENDER, ELDERLY AND CHILDREN) (MINISTRY OF HEALTH, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, GENDER, ELDERLY AND CHILDREN) ORDER, 2020

Citation and
Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Value Added Tax (Exemption) (National Tuberculosis and Leprosy Programme NTLP)) (Provision of Cleaning Services of Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children) (Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children) Order, 2020 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th day of November, 2020.

Exemption

2. Subject to the conditions specified in paragraph 3 of this Order, and any other conditions as may be specified by the Commissioner, the whole of the Value Added Tax payable Provision of Cleaning Services of Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children imported or purchased prior to clearance through customs or locally by Care Sanitation and Supplies Limited on behalf of the Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children in Cleaning Services of the Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children project is hereby exempt.

Conditions

3. The exemption granted under this Order shall cease to have effect and the Value Added Tax shall

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become due and payable as if this exemption had not been granted where the said goods or services are used for other purposes, sold or disposed of in any way to another person not entitled to enjoy similar privileges conferred under this Order.

Expiry

4. This Order shall expire on the 31st day of December, 2020.
