(INQUIRY ON PETROLEUM PRODUCTS PRICE SETTING RULES, 2022) NOTICE, 2023

WHEREAS EWURA has received an application from Oil Marketing Companies to review in the pricing rules and the financing costs from 1% as provided under the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (Petroleum Products Price Setting Rules, 2022) to 2.5% and for the Rules to ensure that the computation of the weighted average exchange rate applicable is cost reflective.

AND WHEREAS EWURA is mandated under section 19 of the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority Act powers to conduct inquiry as it is considered necessary for the purposes of carrying out its functions.

NOW THEREFORE Notice to the general public is issued as follows:

Purpose of

2. The purpose of the inquiry is to enable the Authority to collect views on the proposed changes in the cost of financing the importation of petroleum products and to clearly define the exchange rate applicable in the financial market used for the computation of monthly petroleum products prices.
