THE SUGAR INDUSTRY ACT,
(CAP. 251)

ORDER

(Made under section 11A)

THE SUGAR INDUSTRY (INDICATIVE PRICE OF SUGAR) ORDER, 2024

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Sugar Industry (Indicative Price of Sugar) Order, 2024.

Application

2. This Order shall remain in force from date of publication until 30th June 2024.

Maximum retail and wholesale prices

3.-(1) The retail and wholesale price of sugar shall depend on the specific area.

(2) The maximum price for sale of sugar in each Region shall be as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

Monitoring of sugar prices

4. The Board shall, in collaboration with relevant authorities, monitor compliance with this Order.

Review of indicative prices

5. Indicative prices set out in this Order shall be reviewed by the Board from time to time as need may arise.

Offences

Cap. 251

6. Any person who sells sugar in violation of the indicative prices set out in the Schedule, commits an offence and upon conviction is liable to the penalty set out in the provisions of the Sugar Industry Act.
