- Tanzanite (precious minerals)
- Offshore Oil Platform

- Dolphin (indigenous marine life and tourism)
- Mount Kilimanjaro (natural wonders and national symbol)
- Coconut Tree (natural flora and fauna)

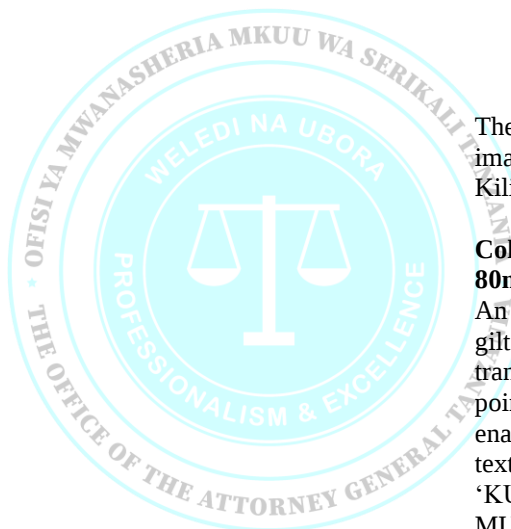

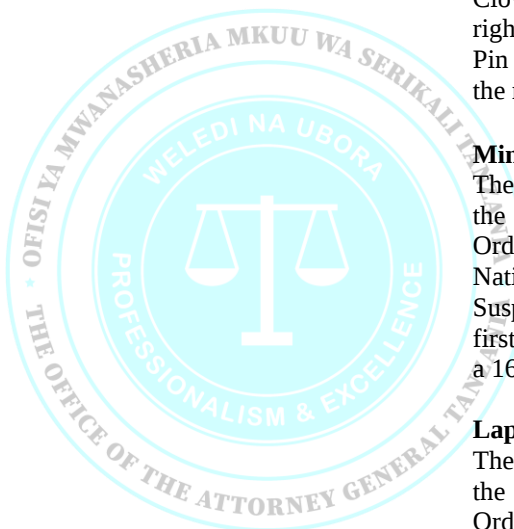
