THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (URBAN AUTHORITIES) ACT

CAP. 288

ORDER

(Made under section 81)

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (URBAN AUTHORITIES) (TRANSFER OF THE POWERS TO
PERFORM FUNCTIONS DUTIES OF APPROPRIATING PARKING PLACES) ORDER, 2021

WHEREAS the Urban Authorities, by virtue of section 62 of the Local Government (Urban Authorities), Cap. 288, have the powers to discharge duties of appropriating parking places and in view of that to establish and maintain parking meters and premises for the parking of vehicles;

WHEREAS the Minister responsible for Local Government, by virtue of section 81 of the Local Government (District Authorities), Cap. 288 has the powers to transfer the powers to perform particular function or functions conferred upon a local government authority to any person or a body of persons;

NOW THEREFORE in the exercise of such powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for Local Government, the following Order is issued:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Urban Authorities) (Transfer of the Powers to Perform Functions of Appropriating Parking Places) Order, 2021.

Transfer of
Powers

2.-(1) Powers of Urban Authorities relating to functions of appropriating parking places, establishing and maintaining parking meters and premises for the parking of

vehicles are transferred to the Tanzania Rural and Urban Roads Agency.

(2) The powers transferred to Tanzania Rural and Urban Roads Agency shall be exercised in road reserves that are maintained by the Agency and this Order shall, not, in any way, affect powers of the Urban Authority to control parking of vehicles, establish and maintain parking meters and premises for the parking of vehicles in any other place other than road reserve.
