PROCLAMATION

(Made under section 6)

THE REGIONS AND DISTRICT (ESTABLISHMENT PROCEDURE) (VARIATION OF
BOUNDARIES OF REGIONS) PROCLAMATION, 2023

WHEREAS in the exercise of the powers conferred by Article 2(2) of the Constitution of the United Republic of Tanzania and in pursuance of the provisions of section 4 of the Regions and Districts (Establishment Procedure) Act, Cap. 397, the President of the United Republic of Tanzania, for the purpose of enhancing proper administration of Regions, did cause to be given a Notice of intention to vary the boundaries Dar es Salaam and Coast Regions situated between Ubungo and Kisarawe Districts and the boundaries of Tanga and Manyara Regions situated between Kilindi and Kiteto Districts as specified in the Notice published in the Gazette as Government Notice No. 644 of 2021 published on 10th September, 2021;

AND WHEREAS from the date of publication of the Notice to the date of expiry of the period of the Notice, no objections or other representations have been received by the President;

NOW THEREFORE, I SAMIA SULUHU HASSAN, the President of the United Republic of Tanzania, in the exercise of powers conferred upon me by Article 2(2) of the Constitution of the United Republic of Tanzania and section 6 of the Regions and Districts (Establishment Procedure) Act, Cap.397, do hereby make the following Proclamation:

Citation

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Regions and Districts (Establishment Procedure) (Variation of Boundaries) Proclamation, 2023.

Proclamation of variation of boundaries

2.-(1) With effect from the date of publication of this Proclamation, the boundaries of Dar es Salaam and Coast Regions situated between Ubungo and Kisarawe Districts and the boundaries of Tanga and Manyara Regions situated between Kilindi and Kiteto Districts shall be varied.

(2) The geographical boundaries of Dar es Salaam and Coast Regions situated between Ubungo and Kisarawe Districts before and after variation are specified in the First Schedule to this Proclamation.

(3) The geographical boundaries of Tanga and Manyara Regions situated between Kilindi and Kiteto Districts before and after variation are specified in the Second Schedule to this Proclamation.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(Made under paragraph 2(2))

A: THE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF DAR ES SALAAM AND COAST REGIONS SITUATED BETWEEN UBUNGO AND KISARAWA DISTRICTS AS PER GN NO. 41 OF 1974

“Thence North westerly and westerly along a cut line to meet the mbungo River; thence down the mbungo river for about 1 mile; thence in a Northely direction to the main Dar es Salaam - Morogoro Road; thence in a Westerly direction along the Dar es Salaam – Morogoro Road to the Mpiji river bridge.”

B: THE VARIED GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF DAR ES SALAAM AND COAST REGIONS SITUATED BETWEEN UBUNGO AND KISARAWA DISTRICTS

“Thence following Kimara to Kinyerezi ward boundaries in a generally South West direction for approximately 4.1 kilometres; thence Westerly for 2 kilometres to a point 9243249.705, 512633.768 which is 1.6 kilometres North of survey mark TP17 (9241631.218, 512721.772); thence North westerly through a cut line (TANGANYIKA SHEET NO. 186/III ^{*South B-37*}_{*P-III-SW*}) a

point PT4 (9244539.44, 510286.79) thence south west to a point SAT 757; thence south to a point SAT 730; thence south eastly to a point SAT 731; thence southward to a point SAT 732; thence south to a point SAT 733; thence south west to a point SAT 734 west northly to a point DDR 321; thence north direction to a point DDR 320; thence northward to a point DDR 319; thence north west to a point DDR 318; thence northward to a point DDR 317; thence south west to a point DDR 316; thence south to a point DDR 315; thence south west to meet the point AIA 542; thence north west to a point AIA 581; thence westerly to a point AIA 679; thence southward to a point AIA 676 and south to a point AIA 675 and westly to a point SAT 741; thence north west for 1.089 kilometer to meet the point SAT 740; thence to SAT 739; thence northly to a point SAT 738 and northly to a point SAT 737; thence through intermediate points SAT 743, SAQ 977, SAQ 978, SAQ 982, SAQ 983, SAQ 979, SAQ 980, SAQ 975, SAT 735, SAT 736 to SAT 719 ,all these points are on the survey plan No. E1/341/254 to Mloganzila road, thence northerly direction along Mloganzila road; to the main Dar es Salaam – Morogoro Road; thence in a westerly direction along the Dar es Salaam - Morogoro Road to the Mpiji River Bridge.”

SECOND SCHEDULE

(Made under paragraph 2(3))

A: THE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF TANGA AND MANYARA REGIONS SITUATED BETWEEN KILINDI AND KITETO DISTRICTS AS PER GN. NO. 65 OF 1961

“Thence in a north-easterly direction skirting the west slopes of Bariron to Lemedian (Lomodian)Hill: thence in a north-easterly direction in a straight line to Sambu Hill; thence in a north-westerly direction in a straight line to the southern spur of Ndege (Mwandege) Mountain; thence due north for about three miles to a point on Ndege Mountain; thence in a north-easterly direction for about eleven along the watershed of Ndege Mountain to the highest point on Bokwa range; thence in a north-westerly direction for about two miles to Lengatei Hill. Thence in a north-easterly direction in a straight line to Kama (Nkama) Mountain; thence in a north-north-easterly direction in a straight line to Losikitok Mountain”.

B: THE VARIED GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES OF TANGA AND MANYARA REGIONS SITUATED BETWEEN KILINDI AND KITETO DISTRICTS

“Thence from Lomodian (Ngineji) Hill with coordinates 9342598.100,285121.644 through point KPG1 with coordinates 9343543.048, 285121.644 to points; NP1 (9346131.863,281423.595), KPG2 (9348104.745,286625.443), KPG3 (9351625.000,285007.591), KI-GK (9352160.000,283977.000), KARATU HILL (9355614.000,285756.000), KI-KI1 (9359622.000,288045.000),KI-KI2 (9360238.00,289866.000), KI-KI3 (9361034.000,292209.000),KI-KI4 (9361516.000,295230.000), KI-KI5 (9362784.000,297982.000), KPG4 (9363124.133,299414.413) to Sambu Hill (9364275.610,300254.910); thence from Sambu Hill to points KI-KI81 (9364832.993,300231.650), KI-KI82 (9365832.966,300190.448), KI-KI83 (9366831.013,300149.242), KI-KI84 (9367830.739,300106.900), KI-KI85(9368830,520,300066.528), KI-KI86 (9369829.383,300024.623), KI-KI87(9370828.276,299983.454) and KI-KI88 (9371826.540,299943.914). Thence from boundary pillar No.KI-KI88 (9371826.540, 299943.914)

in a north-easterly direction along the watershed of Mwandege Mountain to the highest point on the Bokwa Mountain range (146 ST 1) with coordinates 9383065.000, 304326.000. Thence from Bokwa Mountain (146 ST 1) the boundary goes in a straight line to point P15 (9383634.707, 302992.227) along Lengatei Hill. Thence from point P15 (9383634.707, 302992.227) on Lengatei Hill to boundary Point No. P 16 (9384922.184,303864.605), to boundary Point No. P17 (9386072.988,304740.968) to boundary Point No. P18 (9386677.882,305297.794) to Boundary Point No. P19 (9387607.492,306234.784) to Boundary Point No. P20 (9388022.463,306663.759) to Boundary Point No. P21 (9388826.097, 307169.022) and Boundary Point No. P22 (9388978.574, 307343.031) on the Nkama mountain; thence from this point the Boundary goes in a north-north direction in a straight line point to boundary Point P23 (9399599.220,311609.016), to Boundary Point No. P24 (9399812.061,311708.700) and then through boundary point No. P25 (9419021.832,319381.382) to boundary point No. P26 (9420117.449,319818.988) on the Losikito Mountain”.
