1. These Regulations may be cited as the Land Transport Regulatory Authority (Certification of Commercial Vehicle Drivers and Registration of Crew) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 and shall be read as one with the Land Transport Regulatory Authority (Certification of Commercial Vehicle Drivers and Registration of Crew) Regulations, 2020 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

Amendment

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3 by-

- (a) deleting the words “section 13” appearing in the interpretation of the term “Director General” and substituting for them the words “section 15”; and
- (b) inserting in its alphabetical order the following:
"dangerous goods" means materials or items carried in a motor vehicle that can endanger human safety or health;

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 10(2) by-

- (a) deleting the word “and” appearing at the end of paragraph “(o)”; and
- (b) adding the following paragraphs immediately after paragraph (p)-

- “(q) not drive a vehicle without identity card;
- (r) not drive a vehicle while attending mobile phone;
- (s) not block or obstruct other service providers intentionally; and
- (t) not carry live animal or dangerous goods in a passenger vehicle.”.

4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 13 by deleting the word “fifty” and substituting for it the words “one hundred”.

5. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 18 by adding immediately after subregulation (2) the following-

“(3) An applicant for registration as a crew shall pay to the Authority fees as set out in the Fourth Schedule.”.

6. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 20 by adding immediately after subregulation (2) the following-

“(3) A crew of a commercial vehicle shall be assigned with one hundred points which shall be subjected to demerit point system in a manner prescribed in the Fifth Schedule.”.

7. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 23, by-

(a) in subregulation (1)-

(i) deleting the words “this Act” appearing under and substituting for it with the words “these Regulations”; and

(ii) adding the words “and Seventh Schedule” immediately after the word “Schedule”;

(b) deleting the word “subsection” wherever it appears in subregulation (2) and substituting for it with the word “subregulation”; and

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- (c) deleting the word “section” appearing under subregulation (3) and substituting for it the word “regulation”.
