1. These Regulations may be cited as the Transport Licensing (Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 and shall be read as one with the Transport Licensing (Goods Carrying Vehicles) Regulations, 2020, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

regulation 12
2. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 12.
- Amendment of
regulation 24
3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 24 by-
- (a) renaming paragraphs (a) to (f) appearing immediately after paragraph (b) as paragraphs (c), (d), (e), (e), (f), (g) and (h) respectively; and
 - (b) deleting paragraph (h) as renamed.
- Amendment of
regulation 28
4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 28 by deleting subregulation (4) and substituting for it the following-
- “(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subregulations (1), (2) and (3), the Authority may suspend a licence without issuing notice to show cause where the vehicle-
- (a) has mechanical faults likely to endanger lives of road users and loss of property;

(b) is not equipped with vehicle tracking device;

(c) tracking device is not functioning; or

(d) tracking device is tampered with.

(5) Without prejudice to subregulation (4), the suspension shall cease upon proof of rectification by the Authority.”.

Amendment of
regulation 32

5. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 32 by deleting-

(a) the word “faculties” appearing in subregulation (1)(a) and substituting for it the word “facilities”; and

(b) the word “to” appearing immediately after the word “paid” in subregulation (3) and substituting for it the word “by”.

Amendment of
regulation 33

6. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 33 by-

(a) deleting subregulation (2) and renumbering subregulation (3) as subregulation (2); and

(b) in subregulation (2) as renumbered deleting the words “throughout the journey and records of the same are retained for five years” and substituting for them the words “except for electronic manifest”.

Amendment of
regulation 35

7. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 35 by deleting contents of subregulation (3) and substituting for it the following-

“Subject to subregulation (2)(b)(ii), failure to make refund within a specified period of time may provide right for claiming a full fare.”.

8. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 39 by deleting word “the” appearing between the words “of” and “proof” in paragraph (c).

- Amendment of regulation 43 9. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 43 by deleting the words “this Act” appearing under subregulation (1) and substituting for them the words “these Regulations”.
- Amendment of Second Schedule 10. The principal Regulations are amended in Second Schedule by deleting the words “*(Made under regulations 6, 8 and 14)*” appearing as its enabling provision and substituting for them the words “*(Made under regulation 13)*”.
- Amendment of Third Schedule 11. The principal Regulations are amended in Third Schedule by deleting the words “*(Made under regulation 23)*” appearing as its enabling provision and substituting for them words “*(Made under regulation 22(h))*”.
- Amendment of Fourth Schedule 12. The principal Regulations are amended in Fourth Schedule by deleting the words “*(Made under regulation 34)*” appearing as the enabling provision and substituting for them the words “*(Made under regulation 33)*”.
