THE MEAT INDUSTRY (REGISTRATION OF MEAT INDUSTRY STAKEHOLDERS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2021

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| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Meat Industry (Registration of Meat Industry Stakeholders) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and shall be read as one with the Meat Industry (Registration of Meat Industry Stakeholders) Regulations 2011 herein after referred to as the “principal Regulations.” |

| Amendment of
regulation 2 | 2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 2 by adding in the appropriate order the following definition:
“meat industry stakeholder” means a person involved in business or activity of commercial nature in areas of livestock production and trade, meat trade, slaughtering of livestock, meat processing, livestock market, livestock market operation, livestock exportation and importation, meat input supplier, livestock and meat based associations, meat input manufacturers, meat products marketing agents, butchery, abattoir owner or operator, slaughter man, and slaughter house owner or operator, meat festivals, competition and meat dealers’ suppliers, meat technology teachings of private nature or matters associated thereto. |

Amendment of
regulation 4

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4 by:

(a) deleting subregulation (7) and substituting for it the following:

“A person shall not carryout a business of meat processing, meat storage for imports, meat distribution, meat festivals, butchery, meat import, meat export, livestock commercial production, sell of meat, feed looting, abattoir slaughter establishment and meat transport through meat van without valid certificate of Registration of the Board issued under this regulation.

(b) adding after subregulation (7) as amended the follows:

“(8) Without prejudice to subregulation (7), the Registrar shall keep a register of every Meat Industry Stakeholder.”

Amendment of
regulation 5

4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 5 by deleting the proviso appearing in subregulation (1) and substituting for it the following:

Provided that, registration and retention period shall expire on 30th June, of the next year from the date of registration or retention.

Amendment of
regulation 9

5. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 9 by deleting the words “fifty thousand” appearing in subregulation (1) and substituting for them for the words “one hundred thousand”.

Addition of
regulation 10A

6. The principal Regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 9 the following:

“Compounding
of offences

9A.-(1) The Registrar or any person authorized by him in writing may compound any offence prescribed in the Sixth Schedule to these Regulations by requiring such person to pay a sum of money not exceeding one half of the amount of fine to which

such person would have otherwise been liable to pay if he had been convicted of such offence by filling up the form as prescribed in the Seventh Schedule to these Regulations.

(2) A person whose offence is compounded shall, within three days from the date of being issued with compounding form, have the right to-

- (a) submit his defence;
- (b) admit an offence and mitigate against a penalty.

(3) The Registrar shall, upon considering-

- (a) the defence or mitigation of a person whose offence is compounded;
- (b) the report of the Inspector, if any,

order payment of such sum of money as provided under the Act or these Regulations having consideration to the mitigation factors.

(4) The offender shall with regards to the fine ordered under sub regulation (3)-

- (a) where the offence relates to obstruction of an officer or Inspector in performance of his duties, pay the fine within twenty four hours from the time payment order is made to the offender;
- (b) where the offence compounded is a subsequent offence, pay the fine within fourteen days from the time the payment order is communicated to

the offender; and

- (c) for any other offence not referred in paragraph (a) and (b), pay the fine within fourteen days from the time the payment order is communicated to the offender.

(5) Where a fine is not paid upon the lapse of the time prescribed in subregulation (4), the Registrar may enforce the payment of the fine in court by making application for execution in manner applicable to court.

(6) Without prejudice to any other requirement, the application stated in sub-regulation (5) shall state the principal amount claimed, the interest accrued as per prevailing commercial interest rate and mode of execution.”

(v) and in case it is a corporate entity submit further certified corporate registration document(s).
8.	Livestock Market facility	(i) Shall have an approval certificate from relevant authority and in case it is a corporate entity submit further certified corporate

		registration document(s).
9	Meat storage facility	(i) Shall have TIN certificate, and in case it is a corporate entity submit further certified corporate registration document(s).
10	Importer	(ii) Shall have valid TIN certificate and certified certificate of registration in case the Importer is a company or partnership or trading in association form.
11	Exporter	(iii) Shall have valid TIN certificate, and certified certificate of registration in case the Importer is a company or partnership or trading in association form.
12	Egg point wholesale shops/suppliers	(i) Shall have valid TIN certificate, and in case the dealer is the company or partnership, then plus certified company documents and certificate of registration. (ii) Shall have physical address of business.
13	Any other stakeholder where registration is required but not stated herein	(i) Submit introduction letter from the relevant local authority, and where TIN certificate is applicable, then the relevant TIN certificate.
