THE GAMING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024

Citation and
commencement

385 of 2003

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming (Amendment) Regulations, 2024 and shall be read as one with the Gaming Regulations, 2003 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations” and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2024.

Addition of
regulation 22D

2. The principal Regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 22C the following:

“Licensing
of dealers
of gaming
activities **22D.**-(1) The Board shall, upon application, licence and issue a certificate to a dealer of gaming activities in the form prescribed in the Second Schedule.

(2) An application for dealer’s certificate in gaming activities shall be made in the form prescribed in the Second Schedule and accompanied by fees as prescribed in the First Schedules.

(3) A certificate issued under subregulation (1) shall be valid for twelve months.”.

Amendment of
regulation 68

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 68(2) by adding immediately after the words “slot machines” the words “or national lottery terminals”.
