2.-(1) Notice is hereby given that the Government intends to vary the boundaries of Mlimba District Council formerly known as Kilombero District Council.

(2) The proposed boundaries of Mlimba District Council are set out in the Schedule to this Notice.

SCHEDULE

PROPOSED BOUNDARIES OF MLIMBA DISTRICT COUNCIL

“Commencing at the confluence of the Ruhudji and Mnyera Rivers; thence down the Mnyera River to its confluence with the Lufile River; thence down the Lufile to its confluence with the Kayeyeya River; thence down the Kayeyeya River to its confluence with the Kilombero River; thence it follows this River Eastwards to a point with reference 233760.160E, 9088367.330; thence turns Northward at a bearing of 90°00’00’’ and a distance of 9192.37 meters to beacon number BAD619; thence turns Northward at a bearing of 345°58’42’’ and a distance of 4595.114 meters to beacon number BAG598; thence turns slightly at a bearing of 324°19’25’’ and a distance of 4131.400 meters to beacon number BAB599 at the bridge of Doko River (a point at the crossing of this River by a road to Mlimba); thence it follows this River Northwards to a beacon number BAB 618; thence it turns at a bearing of 329°37’31’’ and a distance of 1960.652 to beacon number BAB602; thence turns Northwards at a bearing of 90°00’00’’ and a distance of 9107.78 meters to a point referred to 229659.119E, 9121651.986N; thence directly Westwards and bearing slightly South-Westwards at a distance 5331.05 to a point with reference 224350.327E, 9121556.859N; thence South-wards for about 15.37 miles passing at a point with reference 213410.33E, 9116527.30N to the Ruipa River; thence down the Ruipa for some 12 mile to its confluence with the Londo and continuing for 15 miles to Hange; thence South-Westwards some 35 miles; thence more directly South-wards to the source of a tributary of the Mpanga River; thence up the Mpanga in a Northerly direction for about 20 miles; thence in a Westerly direction South of the Ruiga River for about 18 miles; thence South-West for about 5 miles until it meets the Ruaha River East of Makungu; thence down the Ruaha South-wards for about 18 miles; thence South-South Westwards to the source of the Liawana River which it follows Southwards to its confluence with another Ruaha River; thence in a South-Easterly direction to Tembolino Hill (2870ft); thence in the same direction for about 13 miles; thence due South for about 5 miles to a point on the Ruhudji River ½ mile West of Mwakilindo village; thence down the Ruhudji River to its confluence with the Mnyera River the point of commencement.”
