THE TOURISM (FEES AND CHARGES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024

Citation and commencement

GN. No. 267 of 2015 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Tourism (Fees and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024 and shall be read as one with the Tourism (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2015, hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

Deletion and substitution of regulation 4

2. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 4 and substituting for it following:

"Fees for temporary permit of overland tourist truck or special foreign tourist air charter 4. Fees for temporary permit of an overland tourist truck or a special foreign tourist air charter shall be as prescribed in the Third Schedule to these Regulations.".

Deletion of regulations 5 and 6

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulations 5 and 6.

Deletion and substitution of Second and Third Schedules **4.** The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the Second and Third Schedules and substituting for them the following:
