1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Laboratories Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024 and shall be read as one with the Fisheries (Laboratory Fees) Regulations, 2012 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations” and shall come into operation on 1st July, 2024.
