Citation	1. This Notice may be cited as the Mining (Exemption of Trading Certain Minerals from Mineral and Gem Houses) Notice, 2024.
Exemption of certain minerals	2.-(1) The minerals specified in the Schedule to this Notice are hereby exempted from being traded at the established Mineral and Gem Houses. (2) Without prejudice to subparagraph (1), the Commission shall establish mobile or stationary buying centres designated near areas with mining activities for the minerals specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
Cap. 123 GN No. 418 of 2019	(3) The mobile or stationary buying centres referred to under subparagraph (2) shall be deemed to have the same status as the Mineral and Gem Houses established under the Mining Act and the Mining (Mineral and Gem Houses) Regulations, 2019.
