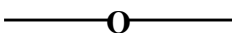

THE PUBLIC LEADERSHIP CODE OF ETHICS (CONTROL OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST)
REGULATIONS, 2020

PART I
PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

- Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Leadership Code of Ethics (Control of Conflict of Interest) Regulations, 2020.
- Interpretation 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:
- Cap.398 “Act” means the Public Leadership Code of Ethics Act;
 “child” has the meaning ascribed to it under the Act;
 “conflict of interest” has the meaning ascribed to it under the Act;
 “family” means a group consisting of parents and their children living together as a unit;
 “fundraising” means an act or process of collecting funds from organizations, companies or individuals for the purposes of providing support or political activity;
 “gift” means something that is voluntarily given to a public leader to show kindness or respect for an event or a sign of appreciation;
 “hospitality” means custom or practice in the community of accepting or welcoming guests by providing them with food, refreshment or entertainment;
 “public leader” or “leader” means a public leader as defined by the Act;
 “relatives” means people who are directly related or otherwise to the leader by birth, marriage or adoption and

includes biological children above eighteen years of age.

PART II CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Conflict of
interest

3.-(1) A conflict of interest for the purposes of these Regulations, includes where a public leader has a personal interest that-

- (a) affects the implementation of his responsibilities to the public;
- (b) may affect the implementation of his responsibilities to the public; and
- (c) appears to affect the implementation of his responsibilities to the public.

(2) A public leader shall be considered to have a conflict of interest for the purposes of these Regulations, where the leader-

- (a) makes decisions or participates in any decision-making process related to his authority, duties or office contrary to the laws, regulations, procedures and public interest;
- (b) uses his office directly or otherwise for personal benefit or to assist another person to gain benefit contrary to law and ethical principles;
- (c) uses information obtained in the course of his official duties and which is not yet publicly disclosed, for personal benefit or to assist someone else to gain benefit;
- (d) participates, influences or enables implementation of development projects in the area that he has interest without taking into regard the national policies, national priorities and equitable distribution of national resources;
- (e) participates in the process of making decisions or making decisions on any matter relating to himself, his company or any other person with whom he has a relationship such as family, close relatives or companies in which those persons have interest;

- (f) uses his office to assist a company or an individual in their dealing with the Government in the context that would result in preferential treatment to any person;
- (g) obtains financial interest or is employed by a private company with which he had been affiliated during his tenure of office, within six months after retirement;
- (h) exerts improper influence in appointing or promoting his spouse, child, parent, relative or any other person contrary to the Public Service Act, and its Regulations and procedures;
- (i) exerts improper influence in taking disciplinary action or dismissing the public officer from the public service contrary to the Public Service Act and its Regulations and procedures;
- (j) compels members of the Tender Board to award tender to a company, organization or institution contrary to procedures laid by the law;
- (k) uses public resources for personal gain or assists any other person to gain benefit;
- (l) participates in activities outside his employment that affect the implementation of his responsibilities to the public;
- (m) the leader's spouse, parents or children or any company or association to which he is affiliated enter into or take any part in any contract with the Government or entity of the Government which is under direct management of the leader;
- (n) has personal interest in a company or organization that affects the public duties he discharges;
- (o) assists his relatives or any other person in matters related to his official duties without following the procedure; and
- (p) engages in a fundraising event or raises funds from any individual or any institution in order to obtain personal benefits.

Responsibilit

4.-(1) It shall be the responsibility of every public

y to disclose
conflict of
interest

leader to-

- (a) report to the Ethics Commissioner regarding any incidence of conflict of interest that comes to his knowledge in the performance of his official duties; and
- (b) declare to the Ethics Commissioner, the personal interest he has if such interest is contrary to the implementation of his official duties.

(2) Where the Ethics Commissioner considers that the interest declared by the public leader in terms of sub-regulation (1)(b) affects or may affect the execution of the public leader's duties, the Ethics Commissioner shall advise the public leader's disciplinary authority to direct such a public leader the proper action to be taken to control the conflict of interest.

(3) The declaration referred to in sub-regulation (1)(b) shall be made in the prescribed Form A set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(4) The Ethics Commissioner may give advice or direction to the public leader who makes a declaration of personal interests which conflict with his official duties in accordance with sub-regulation (1)(b).

(5) Every public office shall open and maintain an interests and conflict of interest register which will be as prescribed in Form B set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Disclosing
interest in
decision-
making
sessions

5.-(1) Where a public leader has direct pecuniary interest, affiliation or otherwise in a matter being discussed at any meeting or any formal decision-making session such as the Cabinet, the Parliament, the Local Government Council, the Board or its Committee or any part of it, he shall disclose the interest he has in the session or part thereof before the discussion.

(2) A disclosure made pursuant to sub-regulation (1) shall be made by declaration orally and in writing as prescribed in Form C set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(3) A declaration of conflict of interest made by a public leader in accordance with sub-regulation (2) shall be

recorded in the minutes of that meeting.

(4) The Secretary to the Cabinet, the National Assembly, the Local Government Council or its Committee shall keep and maintain the register of interests and conflict of interest.

(5) Pursuant to sub-regulations (3) and (4) and without prejudice to the rules governing Parliamentary and Cabinet meetings, the declaration made by a leader shall be submitted to the Ethics Secretariat within two weeks after the relevant session or meeting for reference and monitoring.

PART III

GIFTS AND OTHER BENEFITS TO PUBLIC LEADERS

Prohibition
of solicitation

6.-(1) A public leader shall not solicit, request or accept gifts or hospitality contrary to the procedure laid down by the Act and these Regulations.

(2) A public leader shall not solicit, request or accept gifts or hospitality from persons whom he has relationship with, in execution of his official responsibilities.

(3) Without prejudice to the provisions of section 12(1)(e)(i),(ii) and (iii) of the Act, a public leader shall not receive a gift of the value exceeding two hundred thousand shillings where such a gift affects his integrity or execution of official duties or brings perception of a preferential treatment or conflict of interest.

(4) The public leader shall, where he receives a gift of the value exceeding two hundred thousand shillings-

(a) declare the received gift and its value by filling the prescribed Form D set out in the Schedule to these Regulations within seven days from receipt of the gift; and

(b) submit the declaration made pursuant to paragraph (a) and the gift to the accounting officer of the office in which he is employed.

(5) The public office which receives declaration of gift in terms of sub-regulation (4) shall cause the gift to be recorded in the gift register.

Gift register

7.-(1) Every public office shall keep and maintain a

gift register into which shall be kept information and details of gifts declared by public leader.

(2) The gift register referred to in sub-regulation (1) shall be as prescribed in Form E set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

8. Where a gift is submitted to an accounting officer pursuant to the regulation 6(4), the accounting officer shall-

(a) maintain the gift in a safe environment:

Provided that, where the gift is of a perishable nature, the accounting officer may decide as soon as practicable the use of such gift; and

(b) where the gift is intended to be a public property, receive and dispose of the gift in accordance with the procedures prescribed in Public Procurement Act and the Public Procurement Regulations:

Provided that before using or disposing the gift, the accounting officer shall cause it to be recorded in the assets register like any other public asset.

AVOIDANCE OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Avoidance of
conflict of
interest

10.-(1) A public leader shall avoid conflict of interest and where it arises, the public leader shall resolve it in the public interest.

(2) Without prejudice to the provisions of sub-regulation (1), conflict of interest may be avoided by a public leader by-

(a) declaring the pecuniary interest he has on the matter being discussed in the Cabinet, Parliament,

- Local Government Council or its committees, or any other decision-making sessions before speaking on that matter;
- (b) refraining from acting or making decisions in furtherance of his private interest or interests of the members of his family or any other person for whom he has fiduciary relationship;
 - (c) making declaration of assets, income, interest, liabilities and gifts;
 - (d) making declaration of interest in Government contracts;
 - (e) refraining from business, professional activities or other activities that lead him into conflict of interest;
 - (f) resigning from the post that leads him into conflict of interest;
 - (g) disclosing any form of employment held at the time, whether in the public service or private sector; or
 - (h) any other way as the leader may be directed or advised by the Ethics Secretariat or his accounting officer.

PART V

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Compliance
with these
Regulations

11.-(1) A public leader shall comply with the requirements stipulated in these Regulations.

(2) Any public leader who acts contrary to these Regulations shall be deemed to have violated the provisions of the Act.

Advice on
implementation

12. For the effective implementation of these Regulations, a public leader or public office may consult the Ethics Commissioner for guidelines, explanation or advice regarding the promotion of Public Leadership Ethics, ethical dilemmas, implementation of the Act and these Regulations.

PART I
PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Citation	1. These Regulations may be cited as the Land Use Planning Regulations, 2020.
Application	2. These Regulations shall apply to all land use plans prepared by planning authorities under the Act.
Interpretation	3. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-
Cap. 116	“Act” means the Land Use Planning Act; “adult” means a person aged above 18 years; “approving authority” when used in relation to approval of a national, zonal, regional or district land use plan means the Minister, and when used in relation to approval of a village land use plans means the respective village assembly; “authority” means a respective planning authority issuing an enforcement notice or an order under these Regulations; “code” means an identity number, letter, or mark given to a respective district or region under these Regulations;
Caps. 113 and 114	“Court” means the courts established under the Land Act and the Village Land Act;
Cap. 287	“district” has the meaning ascribed to it under the Local Government (District Authorities) Act; “Minister” means the Minister responsible for land use planning; “notice” means an enforcement notice under section 48 of the Act; “ordinary working days and hours” means days of a week except saturday, sunday and public holiday between 8.30 Am and 3.30 PM; “order” means a land restoration order under section 53 of the Act; “Region” means any part of Mainland Tanzania proclaimed or deemed to be proclaimed by the President to be a region pursuant to the powers conferred on him by the Constitution of the United Republic or by any

other authority under the powers conferred on it by the appropriate law for the time being.

PART II DISTRICT COORDINATION

Establishment
of PLUM
team

4.-(1) In order to ensure effective systematic physical development, Inter-sectoral and village land use planning coordination, the District Land Use Planning Authority shall establish a District Participatory Land Use Management Team to be known as the “PLUM team”.

(2) The PLUM team shall consist of eight but not exceeding ten members who are technical officers with different disciplines from land resource based sectors such as lands, agriculture, livestock, forestry, infrastructure (roads), wildlife, water resources, environment, community development and legal.

(2) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as a member of the PLUM team unless that person -

- (a) has knowledge of and experience in land-use planning and management;
- (b) has knowledge of and experience in participatory approaches;
- (c) has good communication skills both oral and written as well as knowledge in computer applications;
- (d) has an ability to gather various information, analyse and present results in a comprehensive manner;
- (e) is able and prepared to be in the field for most of the time.

(3) At least two members of the PLUM team appointed under sub regulation (2), shall be conversant with GIS applications to support the team with map preparations using GPS, satellite images and computers.

(4) In appointing the PLUM team, the appointing authority shall consider gender.

(5) The PLUM team may co-opt any person to attend and deliberate on specific matter as the team may determine

but such person shall not have the right to vote.

PART III GUIDELINES, PROGRAMMES AND ACTION PLAN

5.-(1) For the purpose of implementing its functions under the Act and these Regulations the Commission shall, in consultation with stakeholders, prepare and periodically review guidelines for preparation of land use plans and land management for different levels.

(2) Every land use planning authority shall prepare programmers and action plans for preparations and implementation of land use plans in its area of jurisdiction in accordance with the Act.

(3) The guidelines, programs and action plans prepared under this regulation shall strive to balance the interests of attaining uniformity of guidelines, programs and action plans within respective authority against the prevailing differences within the authority.

(4) The guidelines, programs and action plans to be prepared under this regulation-

- (a) shall be practicable and not in any manner inconsistent with the best use of the land concerned;
- (b) may be of a short or long term as the authority may deem fit.

PART IV REGIONAL AND DISTRICT CODE

6.-(1) Except where specifically provided otherwise by the Act or any regulation made under the Act, regions and districts in Mainland Tanzania shall, for purposes of execution of the provisions of the Act, be cited by reference to the names given by their establishing instruments and where given under these Regulations by reference to the Code numbers, given under this Part.

(2) The regions specified in Column B of the First Schedule are hereby assigned Code numbers specified against them in Column A and the districts whose names

appear in Column C are hereby assigned Code numbers appearing against their names in Column D.

7. (1) The approving authority shall, upon approving a respective land use plan, number the land use plan in a manner prescribed in these Regulations.

(2) Where it appears to the Minister before publication of any approved land use plan that such a plan has not been numbered, the Minister may alter the number of that plan in a manner prescribed under this Part.

(2) The modification of number in a land use plan by the Minister under sub regulation (1) shall take effect from the date of publication of the notice under section 36 of the Act and shall thereupon replace the number existing prior to the modification.

(3) The effective date of application of a number of an approved plan in all other cases shall be the date on which a respective plan is approved by a respective approving authority.

(4) For avoidance of doubt, a number approved by the approving authority shall be and remain to be the respective plan's number under these Regulations unless and until it is modified by the Minister.

(2) Nothing in these Regulations shall be taken to prohibit a map or any kind of drawing in respect of any land use plan to bear, in addition to the respective plan number, an elaborative description to distinguish it from a different map or drawing under the same plan or to indicate the fact that the drawing is a map or drawing part of the plan, and not itself the plan.

(3) The plan shall, upon modification, be read and for all purposes used as modified with effect from the date of the modification appearing at the modified part of the plan.

18.-(1) All land use plans shall be submitted to the Commission for scrutiny and technical verification, after which the Commission shall submit them to the Minister for approval and or publishing in case of district or zonal land use framework plans, whereas, approved village land use plans shall be submitted to the Minister for publishing.

(2) A notice of approval of a land use plan by a village assembly or the Minister, as the case may be, with or without modification, shall be published by the Minister in LUP Form No. 2 and 3 respectively of the Nineteenth Schedule.

(3) When the Commission forms an opinion that a certain approved plan be revoked or be amended in some manners, it shall publish in the *Gazette* or widely circulated newspaper or on local government notice boards, a notice to the public informing the public of the said opinion and invite any person affected or with a different opinion to file an objection or representation before it within thirty days from the date of publication.

(4) The notice under sub regulation (2) shall-

(a) be substantially in Form No. 4 which is

prescribed in the Nineteenth Schedule.; and

- (b) state the reason for proposed modification or revocation, which must fall within the circumstances enumerated in section 38 of the Act and in case of a modification, the kind of modification suggested.

(5) The objections or representations shall be typed or written in legible capital letters and shall state full names and residential, postal and telephone (if any) address of the person filing the objection/representation and state and explain clearly the grounds of objection/representation.

19.-(1) Upon expiry of the time fixed by the Commission for the lodging of objections and representations, the Commission shall consider the representations and objections and make its decision either to proceed with the intended proposal for revocation or modification or to make such alterations on it or make any decision as the representations or objections may have led it to opine at this time.

(2) In the process of dealing with the objections, the Commission shall be at liberty to invite the person objecting or any person it may consider fitting to explain or give opinion regarding the objection or representation but, the Commission shall not be bound by such opinion and or explanation.

20.-(1) When the Commission resolves to proceed with the proposal for modification or revocation, it shall lodge its proposal in Form No. 5 of the Land Use Planning (Forms) Regulations, 2018 to the Minister for approval of the proposed modification or revocation of the approved plan.

(2) Upon receiving the proposal for modification or revocation of an approved land use plan, the Minister may either give or withhold his approval in respect of the proposed modification or revocation.

(3) Where the Minister refuses to approve the proposed modification or revocation, he shall provide written reason for the decision, and in case the Minister is of

the opinion that a proposal may receive approval upon alteration in certain parts, the Minister shall state so.

(4) Where the Commission intends to submit a proposal for modification or revocation in respect of the same approved plan whose proposed modification or revocation was previously refused by the Minister-

- (a) the new proposal shall, if it is substantially based on different reasons and or affecting the proposed plan from the way it was affecting it in the previous proposal, first be published in the *Gazette* and follow all the procedures as if it were a new proposal under section 38 of the Act; or
- (b) in cases where the reason or effect of the proposed modification/revocation is substantially the same as in the previous case, the proposal shall be lodged with the Minister straight without undergoing a process of publication and invitation and handling of objections and representations under section 38 (2) of the Act.

PART VII CUSTODY OF LAND USE PLAN

21. The relevant authority shall be custodian of all approved land use plans and shall be responsible for availability of land use plans to any member of the public for inspection and purchase of land use plans.

(2) Plans approved by the Minister or a Village Assembly under the Act and reports accompanying them shall be available for inspection or sale to any member of the public upon payment of inspection fee prescribed in the Eighth Schedule.

(3) A plan shall be sold with all the maps and drawings regarding it already approved.

(4) The reports accompanying the plans or any report shall be sold separately at a price appearing in the Eighth Schedule.

(3) Orders of every year shall be kept in their distinct files in a systematic order starting with the first order number of the authority and ending with the last such order number.

(4) The authority shall keep a stamp with the words 'CANCELLED/ Date ' and another stamp with the words 'EFFECTED/ Date ...' which shall be affixed on copies of the orders kept in the files mentioned in this regulation which have been cancelled or whose requirements have been satisfied respectively, with the date of a decision of the authority canceling or ruling satisfaction of the order appearing in the dash marks as per regulation 32(3) of actions after enforcement notices and enforcement orders.

37. The regional and district codes to be used in all orders under these Regulations shall be those codes prescribed under regional and district codes.

PART X

ENFORCEMENT NOTICES AND RESTORATION ORDERS

Service of notice and order

38.-(1) Service of notices and orders issued under section 48 or 53 of the Act shall be done in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations.

(2) A notice shall be affixed to a conspicuous place

of the office of the local council and in any other conspicuous public places within the area of jurisdiction, which the planning authority shall direct.

(3) A notice or order shall be duly served on the owner, occupier or developer to whom it is addressed when received by either such owner, occupier or developer or by an adult person who for the time being is taking charge of the land on behalf of such owner, occupier or developer.

(4) For purposes of these Regulations, a person shall be taken to be taking charge of the land if in relation to the land he is a security guard or a supervisor of a development scheme or any project on the land or a person engaged to give material information to such owner, occupier or developer or any person who has close engagement on the land on behalf of the occupier, developer or owner in some other ways as to be directly linked with the occupier, developer or owner.

(5) A notice or order shall be served during the working hours on the ordinary working days but when it appears to the planning authority that compliance with the timing under this provision in a certain case may be impossible or impracticable owing to certain circumstances, the planning authority may authorize service of such notice or order at such other time or day as the authority may deem fit.

(6) A notice or order issued by the authority shall be served on behalf of the authority by any officer of the authority or such other person as the authority may authorize for that purpose.

(7) In respect of any matter on the service of orders or notices not specifically covered in the Act and in these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Procedure Code on the service of summonses shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to such notice or order as if such notice or order were a summons of the court and a respective planning authority were the court and a person serving the same were a proper officer of the court under the Civil Procedure Code.

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PART XI

Compliance

39.-(1) Upon receipt of the notice or order, a person to whom it was addressed shall comply with the order or notice and report to the authority.

(2) Upon receipt of the report under sub regulation (1) or upon the expiry of the period prescribed in the notice or order, whichever comes first, the authority shall conduct inspection to ascertain whether the requirements have been complied with.

(3) Upon the authority being satisfied that the requirements of the notice or order have been satisfied or, for any reason it may record in writing, it finds that it does not intend the said order or notice to remain in force any more, the authority shall record that finding and make a decision lifting the order or notice, as the case may be.

(4) The decision under sub regulation (3) shall mean that the person to whom the notice or order was addressed is exempted from any further question on the basis of the notice or order so lifted.

Provided that, a further notice or order may be issued against that person either regarding the same matter for which the former order or notice was made or on any other matter as the authority may deem it fit at the time of issuing such other order or notice.
