THE MINING (MINERAL AND GEM HOUSES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Mineral and Gem Houses) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024 and shall be read as one with the Mining (Mineral and Gem Houses) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

Amendment of
regulation 15

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 15, by-

(a) adding immediately after subregulation (1) the following:

“(2) Without prejudice to subregulation (1), the Commission may engage any person to organise a mineral auction.”; and

(b) renumbering subregulation (2) as subregulation (3).

Deletion and
substitution of
regulation 16

3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 16 and substituting for it the following:

“Requirements
for participating
in auctions

(1) Any seller who intends to participate in a mineral auction shall pay a fee of the amount as may be determined by the Commission.

(2) A seller who sells minerals at the auction shall pay a commission on minerals sold at the rate which shall, before commencement of such

auction, be determined by the Commission.

(3) An invitee who intends to participate in a mineral auction shall register with the Commission.”.

Amendment of
regulation 17

4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 17 by deleting subregulation (3) and substituting for it the following:

“(3) The process of viewing minerals shall be through a pre-arranged appointment with the auction organiser on a first-come first-served basis.”.

Deletion of
regulation 19

5. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 19.

Amendment of
regulation 20

6. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 20 by deleting subregulation (3).

Amendment of
regulation 22

7. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 22 by deleting subregulation (3) and substituting for it the following:

“(3) Where the winning bidder fails to pay for the minerals won, the Commission shall offer the second highest bidder to buy the minerals.”.
