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| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by Sewage from Ships) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025 and shall be read as one with the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by Sewage from Ships) Regulations, 2024, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”. |

| Amendment of
regulation 3 | 2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3 by adding in the appropriate alphabetical order the following new definition:
““Administration” means the Government of the State whose flag the ship is entitled to fly;”. |
| Amendment of
regulation 14 | 3. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting regulation 14 and substituting for it the following:
““Prohibition on Tanzanian ship proceeding to sea without sewage certificate |
| | 14. Subject to regulation 21, a Tanzanian ship to which these Regulations apply shall not proceed to sea or if it is already at the sea, remain at sea unless-
(a) an initial survey or a renewal survey has been carried out in respect of the ship; and
(b) a sewage certificate has been issued in respect of that ship and is still valid.”. |
