THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (URBAN AUTHORITIES) (VARIATION OF
BOUNDARIES OF IFAKARA TOWN COUNCIL) ORDER, 2020

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the provisions of section 11 of the Local Government (Urban Authorities) Act, Cap. 288, the Minister responsible for local government did issue notice of the intention to vary boundaries of Ifakara Town Council as specified in the Notice published in the *Gazette* as Government Notice no. 307A of 2020.

AND WHEREAS, no objection or representation was received by the Minister such as would justify any delay in varying boundaries of the Ifakara Town Council until the expiry of the Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for local government by the provisions of section 11 of the Local Government (Urban Authorities) Act, Cap. 288, the following Order is issued:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Urban Authorities) (Variation of Boundaries of Ifakara Town Council) Order, 2020.

Variation of
boundaries

2. The boundaries of an area under the jurisdiction of Ifakara Town Council are hereby varied as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

(Made under paragraph 2)

BOUNDARIES OF IFAKARA TOWN COUNCIL

“Commencing at the confluence of the Rufiji and Myamera Rivers the boundary follows the Rufiji down to its confluence with the Great Ruaha Rivers; thence following the Great Ruaha to its confluence with the Maji Matitu River; thence up the Ruaha to a point at the crossing of this river by a road just South of Kidatu; thence South-West for 81/2 Miles to Muhame Hill; thence South-East to Mbokera Hill; thence continuing to Funda fundu Hill; thence South –East for 4 miles to a point near Lukwambi on Ifakara-Kiberege Road; thence directly Westwards passing South of Kirama and bearing slightly North-Westwards; thence Southwards to a point referred 229659.119E,9121651.986N; thence boundary turns Southwards at bearing of 270°00’00’’ and a distance of 9107.78 metres to BAB602; thence turns South-East at a bearing 149°37’31’’ to a beacon number BAB6018 and a distance of 1960.652 metres ; thence turns slightly Southwards following the Doko River to a point number BAB599 at the bridge of Doko River (a point at the crossing of the River by road to Mlimba; thence follows this River; thence it follows this South-East at a bearing 144°19’25’’ of and distance of 4131.400 metres to a beacon number BAB598; thence turns slightly South-East to a bearing of 165°58’42’’ and a distance of 4595.114 meters; thence turns Southwards at a bearing 270°00’00’’ and a distance of 9192.37 metres to a point with reference 233760.160E;9088367.330N, (at the Kilombero River); thence turns East-wards following the Kilombero River to the confluence of this river with the Rufiji River to its confluence with the Myamera River the point of commencement.”.
