THE LAW OF THE CHILD (CHILD EMPLOYMENT) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Law of the Child (Child Employment) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019 and shall be read as one with the Law of the Child (Child Employment) Regulations, 2012 hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the enabling provision and substituting for it the following:
“(Made under sections 157(d) and (j))”

Regulation 3

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 3, by deleting the words “to suffer” appearing in the definition of the term “hazardous work” and substituting for them the words “of suffering”.

Regulation 4

4. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 4, by-

- (a) deleting the word “under” appearing in sub regulation (1) and substituting for it the word “below”;
- (b) deleting the word “over” appearing in the opening words of sub regulation (2) and substituting for it the words “of or above”.

Regulation 5

5. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 5, by deleting sub regulation (2) and substituting for it the following-

“(2) Save as provided under any other written law, exploitative labour under these Regulations shall have the meaning construed as such under section 78(3) of the Act.”

6. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 7(3), by deleting the word “Ministry” and substituting for it the word “Minister”.

7. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 9(3) by deleting the words “increases risk to health and safety” appearing in paragraph (a) and substituting for it them the words “subjects the child to health and safety risks”.

8. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 11, by-

- (a) designating the contents of sub regulation (2) as contents of sub regulation (3) and contents of sub regulation (3) as contents of sub regulation (2) respectively;
- (b) deleting sub regulation (2) as designated and substituting for it the following:

(2) A contract shall be read and the details of the contract explained to the child by the caregiver or, in the absence or inability of the caregiver, a local government leader shall assume such responsibility.

Amendment
of Schedule

9. The principal Regulations are amended in the
Schedule-

- (a) in item A by deleting the word “wastes”
appearing in sub item 8 and substituting
for it the words “hazardous waste”.
- (b) in item H by adding immediately after sub
item 18 the following:-

“19. The use, sale or distribution
of cigarettes, alcohol, spirits, drugs or any
intoxicating substance.”
