THE UNIVERSITIES (REVOCATION OF INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL AND
TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY CHARTER) NOTICE, 2022

WHEREAS, the Commission at its 89th General Meeting held on 8th May, 2019 cancelled the Certificate of Accreditation of International Medical and Technological University (IMTU) pursuant to regulation 15(4) of the Universities (General) Regulation, following the total failure to remedy the shortcomings identified by the Commission:

AND WHEREAS, following the cancellation of the Certificate for Accreditation and Registration of IMTU, the President of United Republic of Tanzania, revoked IMTU Charter pursuant to section 29(1) of the Universities Act, Cap. 346;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ADOLF F. MKENDA, the Minister for Education, Science and Technology give notice to the general public pursuant to section 29(2) of the Universities Act, as follows:

Technological University Charter, 2010 has been

revoked.

(2) Subject to subparagraph (1), the International Medical and Technological University shall cease to be a University at the expiry of one year from the date of publication of this Notice.
